

Group Skills Trainers' Pathway

There are 3 levels of certification in the group skills training.

- FACILITATOR
- TRAINER
- STRATEGIC TRAINER

Becoming a trainer permits you to offer authorized training to other professionals in your own agency, or privately in your own region. The Group Skills training is NEVER delivered alone; you are NOT permitted to train others as Group Skills trainers.

As a trainer you will work closely with the Mop Directors Jeannie Gordon and Debbi Barnes, using updated materials, training protocols and completed training evaluations, to name but a few.

The Group Skills trainer training process must be implemented in partnership with Jeannie Gordon and Debbi Barnes.

This assessment involves:

- Evidence of training or teaching accreditation (i.e., STOP trainer, FLASH trainer, Incredible Years mentor, PCG certificate etc.)
- CV and Application Form review – interview may be required.
- Attend the group skills course as an active member.
- Observation training of the training programme
- Co-leading training with Group Skills trainer (Jeannie Gordon or Debbi Barnes).

Cost

You/your service is responsible for any expenses accrued in your travel, accommodation, meals any other expenses required for you to access and implement the Group Skills training.

MoP would charge a train the trainer fee and then a fee for the trainer's groups skills trainers manual. The fee is £1000 per person nominated for the train the trainer programme. The group skills trainer manual is £500. The manual has the content and handout templates for the group skills training.

Post training, group skills trainer requirements

- The training to be co-delivered with another Group Skills trainer.
- You are required to ensure all copyright materials are labelled and marked as copyright protected.
- At the end of the training, you will provide the authors with evaluations and register with us the names of participants who attended the training.
- Each professional on the group skills training is required to be complete and submit a Group Skills registration form.
