

Communication Origami

1. Take a piece of A4 paper.
2. Fold the long side up towards the shorter side and create a crease.
3. The crease should now create a square shape – tear along the crease to make a square piece of paper.
4. Discard the leftover piece of paper (which should be rectangular).
5. Taking your square piece of paper make a vertical crease by folding the right point over to the left point.
6. Unfold the previous step – you will now have a fold line through the centre of your square.
7. Take the bottom right diagonal edge and fold it to line up with the central crease you just made.
8. Repeat on the same steps on the left side.
9. Turn the paper round so that the wide end of your shape is at the bottom.
10. Fold the bottom point up to meet the bottom of the two left and right flaps.
11. Now fold the lower left and right diagonal edges to align with the central vertical crease.
12. Fold your shape in half by bringing the bottom edge up.
13. Fold the front flap back down, leaving a small overlap behind your shape.
14. Your model should now stand up....
