Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving net zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

- Reduce unnecessary business travel by adopting virtual meetings.
- Encourage employee carpooling, cycling, or public transport
- Where possible, consider alternative suppliers offering low-carbon or more sustainable products.
- Evaluate opportunities to streamline procurement processes, reduce waste in purchased materials, and choose local suppliers to minimise transport emissions.
- Reduce single-use items and improve recycling systems.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 97.78 tCO₂e by 2030. This is a reduction of 5.16%.

Declaration and sign off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard

for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard¹³ and uses the appropriate government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting.¹⁴
